Told to speak with Supervisors of Putnam and see what they think.
- Generator to be installed in November. After installed, will look into having one put in for the shop.

- Liquid Fuels audit scheduled for October 21.
- Discussion on bidding on mini excavator. Would like to revisit Bobcat & Kubota with angle blade, same sized machine as currently have.
- Rough estimate on Wilson so far is \$190,282.45. There are 2 bills from Keystone that have not come in yet as well as other bills.
- Secretary advised that Tree Quotes did not come in, to be able to pay out Supervisor Powlison for tree work completed. Supervisors advised to try Dinchure & Dinchure, and Asplundh. Secretary will investigate further.
