April 11, 2022

Chairman Lisowski called the meeting to order at 7:00PM. Present along with the Chairman was Supervisor Powlison, Supervisor Fessler and Secretary Nicole Bennett.

No public comments were made.

- Resolution for fuel escalator clause. Special meeting to be held Friday April 29, 2022 at 9:00AM. Will advertise for meeting and new bids to come in.

Motion to pass: 1<sup>st</sup> – S. Lisowski, 2<sup>nd</sup> – S. Fessler, all ayes.

- Secretary was asked about raising rates for mowing of cemeteries. Last increase was 12+ years ago, which started out at \$50 per mowing & \$15 per weed whacking, then was increased to \$75 total. Supervisor Lisowski made a motion to increase cemetery wages to \$100 per mowing and \$35.00 per Township mowing, 2<sup>nd</sup> – S. Fessler, all ayes.
- Liquid Fuels allocation for 2022 is \$109,856.10, down a little from 2021 which was \$110,371.82.
  - 811 Proclamation, Resolution and Letter (regarding April being the safe digging month).

- Discussion about updating tractor. Supervisor would like to see if the road crew feels a need to update, otherwise just leave as is.
