Regular Monthly Meeting
May 13, 2019

The May 13, 2019 meeting of the Covington Township Board of Supervisor was held in the Covington Township Municipal Building at 114 East Hill Road, Covington PA. - January meeting issue was brought back up about FEE schedule. Changes were made upon request. Copies were provided for each Supervisor. **Motion** was made by S. Lisowski, 2nd by R. Powlison, all ayes.

- Resurface Cherry Flats Road from SR 6 into Cherry Flats – May 2019. Seal Coat Canada Road from Williamson to Covington – July 2019.
- Discussion on pick-up truck and BID process. Supervisors asked Road Master to go ahead with Ray Price as long as we could have a guaranteed date to have the new pick-up before the old one runs out of inspection November 1, 2019.
- All road effected from 2018 floods have been fixed and are completed. Waiting on final approval from FEMA.
- Discussion on uniforms. Unifirst had been in about offering \$25 a week for all employees verses \$45 a week with Cintas. Supervisors asked to get an itemized list from both. (Cintas will not return phone calls, nor will they give any information Secretary has requested. Even through Steve.)
