Regular Monthly Meeting  
July 13, 2020

The July 13, 2020 meeting of the Covington Township Board of Supervisors was held in the Covington Township Municipal Building at 114 East Hill Road, Covington PA/ Chairman Lisowski called the meeting to order at 7:00PM. Present along with the chairman was Supervisor Fessler, Supervisor Powlison and Secretary Nicole Bennett.

No public comments were made.

The Treasurer's report was reviewed and approved.

The Deposit list was reviewed and approved. Secretary advised that Randy Lightner came in to ask for money to be returned from entire road (Barber) getting oil on. Supervisors will look into, speak with Nate on how oil was put down. Thinking that because it was paid for is reason why it seems entire road was oiled.

The Real Estate Transfer report was reviewed.

Payroll/Employee hours were reviewed and approved.

Road Master Report: Road oil and Tar & Chip have been completed. Working on Wilson Road for Dirt & Gravel project.

Zoning Report: Reviewed and approved.

**OLD BUSINESS**

- Andrulonis has completed the order for cinders. Total tonnage was 512.25 tons.
- General Code estimate for updating ordinance book/website from 3 new ordinances that were brought in (November 2019 & June 2020). Supervisors agreed to proceed, Stuart signed paper for rough estimate.
- Supervisor Powlison payment on tree removal. Speaking with Solicitor to make sure everything is okay. Then amount will go to Don White (Payroll Services) to have taxes removed prior to

check. Supervisors good with amount (102 hours @ \$60.00/hr) **Motion** to pass: 1<sup>st</sup> – S. Lisowski,  
2<sup>nd</sup> – S. Fessler.

**NEW BUSINESS**

- Donna had asked about putting wreaths on Covington Township cemeteries for Wreaths Across America. Okay to move forward with, Supervisors would also like Secretary to look into having the Hometown Hero Banners replaced.
  - Temporary road crew member started on June 29. (John Minnich)
  - Received ACT 13 monies, in the amount of \$288,515.16, \$83,006.96 less than 2019.
- Audit was returned – copies provided for each Supervisor. All seems to be okay in good order. Secretary was advised of needing signatures on papers to be returned to Guthrie office before they can close out the audit.
- Discussion on possibility of additional recycle bin for Putnam Township. Supervisors discussed and were okay with Mike Gerow (Putnam Township Supervisor) calling NTSWA to see if they can get a recycle bin and have it delivered to Covington yard.
  - Secretary advised Supervisors that Mark had asked for \$20 more for mowing Township property. Supervisors discussed and agreed that, for a young child doing the mowing \$30 was plenty. They also advised that not all mowing/weed eating gets completed to their liking. \$20 more was denied.
