The October 8, 2018 regular monthly meeting of the Covington Township Board of Supervisors was held in the Covington Township Municipal Building at 114 East Hill Road, Covington PA. Chairman Lisowski called the meeting to order at 7PM. Present along with the Chairman was Supervisor Fessler, Supervisor Powlison and Secretary Nicole Bennett.

Chairman Lisowski asked for public comments on agenda items only. Dave K – asked about sewer extension advising Supervisors he has more people that are interested in.

Minutes of the meeting held on September 10, 2018 were reviewed and approved with Secretary Nicole Bennett advising of corrections made from previous meeting.

The Treasurers Report was reviewed and approved.

The Real Estate Transfer Report was reviewed and approved. With Dave K explaining that Cowan Rd property is also going along with Dark Horse (which was on report).

Road Master Report: Dirt & Gravel road projects as well as more storm damage repair from 1st and 2nd storms that hit Covington.

Zoning Report: Report was reviewed along with permits.

OLD BUSINESS

- Tioga County Emergency Services Response Operation Plan. Plan must be adopted by County or must come up with own plan. Supervisor Powlison made a motion to accept the updated Response Operation Plan. **Motion** to pass: 1st – R. Powlison, 2nd – S. Lisowski, all ayes.

- Advised of Secretary still looking into grant monies to extend sewer.

NEW BUSINESS

- 2019 Liquid Fuels allocation is \$118,698.07, which was \$408.60 less than previous year.
- Supervisor Lisowski advised that Charlotte from Conservation District will be here following morning to pick up paperwork for Tokarz Road to close out and receive other half of money to replenish ACT 13 account.
- Money was received for foreign fire insurance premium tax – it is only received and then disbursed between Blossburg & Mansfield. Amount split was \$6,371.02.
- Subdivision / Lot Addition for Spencer was reviewed and approved. **Motion** to pass: 1st – S. Lisowski, 2nd – R. Powlison, all ayes.

- Supervisor Powlison asked about broken wing wall on Hilfiger. Contacting Scott Bray to see what can be done to fix problem.
- Supervisor Powlison also advised of issue on Cushion Rd with pipe and water. Need to get release of right of way and permit to clean out area in near future. Contact Jim Neil from Conservation District about getting permit. As well as contacting Brian Haight from Penn DOT to see which direction to go to possibly have Penn DOT do work since it is in their right of way not Townships.
- Mike B. asked to take a look at bridge on Palmer to possibly put more rip-rap in temporarily until we can get in to replace bridge next year.

With there being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 7:50PM.
