Regular Monthly Meeting  
October 10, 2016

The October 10, 2016 regular monthly meeting of the Covington Township Board of Supervisors was held in the Covington Township Municipal Building at 114 East Hill Road, Covington PA. Chairman Stuart Lisowski called the meeting to order at 7:00PM. Present along with the chairman was Supervisor Richard Powlison, Supervisor Frank Yungwirth, Assistant Secretary Donna Casselberry and Secretary Nicole Bennett.

Chairman Lisowski advised everyone present at the meeting that we would be holding our regular monthly meeting first and then would go into discussion on Potential Power Plant. Chairman Lisowski asked for Public Comments on Agenda items only. No Comments.

Minutes of the meeting held on September 12, 2016 were reviewed and approved.

**Motion** to pass: 1<sup>st</sup> – S. Lisowski, 2<sup>nd</sup> – R. Powlison, all ayes.

The Treasurers Report: The Treasurers Report was reviewed.

**Motion** to pass (pending audit): 1<sup>st</sup> – S. Lisowski, 2<sup>nd</sup> - F. Yungwirth, all ayes.

The Bills List: The Bill List was reviewed and motion was made to pay bills.

**Motion** to pass: 1<sup>st</sup> – S. Lisowski, 2<sup>nd</sup> – F. Yungwirth, all ayes.

No Real Estate Transfer Report to review.

Payroll/Employee Hours: Report was reviewed for September 2016.

Road Master Report: Road Crew has sand blasted the frame, box and wheels on the Volvo as well as painted (there was a slideshow of updated truck). They also did box repairs on the Volvo. Cleaned out the stream at Palmer Road pipes. They have also gotten all 4 vehicles ready for inspections as well as completed the inspections, and preparing equipment for winter. Mrs. Packard stated that her road has never looked as good as it does now and the Road Crew is doing an excellent job.

Zoning Report: Zoning Violations report was reviewed.

Building Permits: Report was reviewed.

Sewer Permits: 3 reports were reviewed.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

Letter to North Central Sewage – Supervisors signed and is to be sent out to terminate agreement 60 days prior. **Motion** to pass: 1<sup>st</sup> – S. Lisowski, 2<sup>nd</sup> – F. Yungwirth, all ayes.

Resolution to consider passing in regards to Multi Municipal Plan. They have not seen plan (Secretary advised been in contact with Frank and unable to get answers or plan in hand). Supervisors would like to table signing resolution until they have had the chance to read the Comprehensive Plan. **Motion** to table:

**NEW BUSINESS:**

Motion was made to pay off Sewer Loan using ACT 13 money. **Motion** to pass: 1<sup>st</sup> – S. Lisowski, 2<sup>nd</sup> – R. Powlison, all ayes. Dick Cowan asked if monthly bill was still going to be going up since the loan would be paid off. Supervisor Lisowski advised that we hope to keep it the same if not go lower.

Estimated Liquid Fuels allocation for 2017 is \$111,334.41.

Supervisor Powlison read letter aloud from Blossburg Memorial Library. Library is asking for approx. \$1,595.00 in donations from Covington Township. Motion was made to give \$1,200.00 in donations.

**Motion** to pass: 1<sup>st</sup> – R. Powlison, 2<sup>nd</sup> – S. Lisowski, all ayes.

Supervisor Lisowski read letter aloud from Mansfield Foundation. Supervisors would like to table anything regarding this until can get further information.

**Information/Announcements:**

Supervisor Lisowski advised that Secretary and Assistant will be holding Community Events here at the Township office. First one was to be held October 15, 2016 @ 10AM for a Kids Pumpkin Painting.
