Regular Monthly Meeting
March 13, 2017

Secretary advised that Ruth Kovich called in regards to closing of Mansfield University. Zoning Officer Donna Casselberry came up with letter to Matt Baker, Joe Scarnati and PA Board of Governors to send out. All Supervisors approved and signed letter.

Discussion on renting Skid-steer with milling head to fix Starks Road. Approved amount \$638.00.

Supervisor Lisowski stated would like to hire someone to come in and paint lower garage to match rest of buildings. Put bids out in May 2017. Need to discuss further color.

Supervisor Lisowski also stated that would like to have Community BBQ open to anyone that comes down for Recycle and Clean up in May.
