Regular Monthly Meeting
April 10, 2017

The April 10, 2017 regular monthly meeting of the Covington Township Board of Supervisors was held in the Covington Township Municipal Building at 114 East Hill Road, Covington PA. Chairman Stuart Lisowski called the meeting to order at 7:00PM. Present along with the Chairman was Supervisor Richard Powlison, Supervisor Frank Yungwirth and Secretary Nicole Bennett.

Chairman Lisowski asked for Public Comments on Agenda items only.

Road Master Report: Replacing pipes, old 550 finished and put together, finished up winter maintenance. Received message from Wendy Albor in regards to trees hitting school buses on Packard Rd. To get ahold of owners so road crew can trim trees.

Zoning Report: Zoning Violations Report was reviewed. Nothing has changed.

Building Permits Report: Report was reviewed.

- Letter from Cunningham Surveyors in regards to Signor applying for GP8 for temporary stream crossing.

- Secretary advised that road crew member Ron, wife went in for surgery and would like to collect money to purchase flowers and card for get well. Supervisors advised to purchase card and flowers in the amount of \$50.00. Secretary will go next day to order and have delivered.
