Regular Monthly Meeting
June 11, 2018

- Save the Tioga River 2018 Fund Drive, TCCCC. Asking for donation again this year. Mike B spoke about what is going on with projects, advised they are up to about \$117,000 in funds for grant money. - Letter from PSATS for Youth Organization, pamphlets available for each Supervisor. Supervisors chose to put on hold until receive possible suggestion or to pass onto someone local that it would benefit.
- Letter from Tioga County Cares on behalf of County Commissioners. Joining the forum “Rethinking Recovery” on Thursday July 12, 2018 from 9am-4pm at Deane Center in Wellsboro. There was a letter provided for each Supervisor. Supervisors chose to opt out.
