Joe L. also asked about cleaning creek down to Dandy, Supervisors and Road Master advised that was Putnam Township, but Covington is willing to help. County is looking into a county wide stream cleaning.

- Damage Assessment Overview was available to look at for the August 13, 2018 storm disaster. *Penn DOT put assessment together for Emergency Management within Covington Township. *
- Tioga County Emergency Services was tabled again this month. Will bring up following meeting.
- Secretary still looking into grant monies for sewer line extension. USDA is accepting applications for water & waste disposal loan & grant programs.

- Letter from North Central Sewage Agency to use them. We are currently using Ridgerunner SEO and are happy with no problems.
