

## Accepted & Not Accepted Items

The Spring Clean-Up event is open to **residents of Covington Township and Putnam Township only.**

**Proof of residency may be required.**

Please review the following guidelines carefully before attending.

### **ACCEPTED ITEMS**

The following items are generally accepted during the Spring Clean-Up event:

#### **Household & Bulk Items**

- Furniture (chairs, tables, couches, recliners)
  - Mattresses and box springs
  - Dressers, cabinets, and shelving
    - Area rugs
- Large household items that are non-hazardous

#### **Scrap Metal & Metal Items**

- Scrap metal of any kind
  - Metal bed frames
  - Metal lawn furniture
    - Bicycles
  - Empty metal shelving or racks
- Metal appliances **without refrigerants** (*see restrictions below*)

#### **Wood & Miscellaneous Items**

- Wooden furniture (non-construction)
  - Empty plastic lawn furniture
- Non-electronic household items

#### **Paint**

- Latex paint only

- Paint cans must be **completely empty or fully dried**
  - Lids must be removed

### **✗ NOT ACCEPTED ITEMS**

The following items **will NOT be accepted** at the Spring Clean-Up:

#### **Electronics (E-Waste)**

Includes, but is not limited to:

- Televisions
- Computers and laptops
  - Monitors
- Printers and fax machines
  - Tablets
  - Gaming systems
- Stereos, radios, speakers
- Keyboards, mice, cables, and electronic accessories

#### **Appliances Containing Refrigerants**

- Refrigerators
  - Freezers
- Air conditioners
- Dehumidifiers

#### **Household Trash**

- Bagged garbage
  - Food waste
- Daily household refuse

#### **Construction & Demolition Materials**

- Drywall
- Lumber
  - Roofing materials
- Concrete, brick, or block

- Remodeling or demolition debris of any kind

#### Tires

- Tires of any size  
*(Due to disposal costs charged per tire)*

#### Hazardous & Restricted Materials

- Liquid paint
- Oil or automotive fluids
- Chemicals or solvents
  - Batteries
  - Propane tanks
  - Fuel containers
- Asbestos-containing materials

#### Important Notes

- Items not accepted at the Spring Clean-Up may be disposed of **independently by residents** at approved disposal facilities.
- Township staff reserve the right to **refuse any material** that does not meet these guidelines.
- Guidelines are subject to change based on disposal requirements.
